

Common areas, as extensions of individual homes, influence the value and marketability of all homes in a community association. Even residents not interested in marketing their homes care about living in a healthy, well-groomed and attractive environment. *

It is for this reason, the CCTH Management and Board's goal is to maintain and enhance our common elements. Areas of importance include: recreation areas, landscaping, lighting, roads and parking lots, and other exterior elements, including signs and entrances.

Following is a list of common areas that you may not be aware of:

- All land on which the Condominium is built
- Foundations
- Bearing walls and columns
- Attics, roofs and gutters
- Lake, benches, lighting and curbs
- Yards and gardens
 (except for enclosed patios)

A good rule of thumb is that anything outside the exterior 4 walls of your unit is common area (see bylaws for details).
